



NEW JERSEY'S STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM

- In 2015, New Jersey adopted the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) to replace High School Proficiency Assessment (HSPA) and previous assessments in the elementary and middle school in language arts and mathematics.
- Students took PARCC English Language Arts and Literacy Assessments (ELA/L) in grades 3 11.
- Students took PARCC Mathematics Assessments in grades 3 8 and End of Course Assessments in Algebra I

- Level 1: Not yet meeting grade-level expectations
- Level 2: Partially meeting grade-level expectations
- Level 3: Approaching grade-level expectations
- Level 4: Meeting grade-level expectations


